

ISLAMABAD: PRESIDENT AJK VISITS AIR HEADQUARTERS, MEETS PAKISTAN AIR FORCE CHIEF

Sardar Masood Khan, President Azad Jammu and Kashmir, paid a visit to the Pakistan Air Force Headquarters where he was received by the Chief of Air Staff, Air Chief Marshal Mujahid Anwar Khan. On his arrival at the



PAF Headquarter, the AJK President was presented a guard of honour by a smartly turned out contingent of Pakistan Air Force. Pakistan's National Anthem was played which was followed by the inspection of the guard of honour by the President and laying of a floral wreath at the PAF Martyrs Monument.
