

PRESIDENT AJK MEETS CM PUNJAB

Sardar Masood Khan, President Azad Jammu and Kashmir, met Chief Minister Punjab Hasan Askari Rizvi at the Chief Minister Secretariat today.

During the meeting they discussed matters of mutual



interest, political significance and ongoing human rights situation in Indian Occupied Kashmir. The President informed the Chief Minister about the gross human rights violations perpetrated by Indian security forces in IOK and the recent killings of young Kashmiris during so called cordon and search operations.

The President said that efforts are being made to highlight the atrocities taking place and helping put an end to the suffering being inflicted on them by the Indian occupation forces.
